**REGISTRATION**

**PRESENTATION AND PROCEEDINGS**

The official language of the Conference will be English. The speakers should present their contributions in 20 min. Further 5 min are available for discussion. Registered participants will receive one Proceedings copy at the registration desk. Guidelines for the manuscript format will be sent to invited authors. Paper will be limited to 20 pages. Proceedings will be published in an indexed volume by Springer.

**LOCATION AND ACCOMMODATION**

Rome can be reached easily both by train, plane, ship and by car. Tor Vergata Campus is just outside the ring and easy to be reached by public transportation.
